Heritage Cowhide, an enhanced grain Cowhide, is aniline-dyed, Finished cowhide. Its light pigmentation provides a protective finish and high-wear performance, and its natural grain character and soft, comfortable hand create a most aesthetically-pleasing leather.

CHARACTERISTICS:


Durability and built-in protection from soiling, fading, and wear.

More uniformity and less apparent defects than found in Aniline leathers and Classic Cowhide.

A: Permanent natural creases on the hide caused by fat deposits in the live animal usually found in the neck, shoulder, and belly area. Neck wrinkles are less apparent in the Heritage product than in Aniline leathers.

B: Healed wound during life of animal which is characterized by raised surface and inconsistent grain. Scars are less apparent in the Heritage product than in Aniline leathers.

C: Characterized by many clearly visible blood vessels, either closed or cut open by splitting or shaving operations. Veins are less apparent in the Heritage product than in Aniline leathers.
