Our leather is produced from bull and steer hides that are

sourced and tanned in Europe under very strict European environmental standards.

Townsend Leather sources raw material from organizations that utilize picket fence, free range, humanely cared for animals.

The tanning process is strictly regulated in Europe to assure minimal impact on the environment.

Townsend's leathers are all low-VOC products with water-based chemicals and coloring. Our products have been tested and far surpass the minimum standards.

Leather is mankind's oldest textile and is naturally durable. Leather can handle wear and tear that would easily destroy other materials. Leather is known to last an average of 4 times longer than fabric coverings; the endurance of leather is unmatched.



Townsend uses vegetable based re-tanning agents and water-based finishing systems in our entire leather-making process.



1 cinnamon stick (optional, for garnish)



In a teapot, bring the water to a simmer then pour into a mug. Add the whiskey, 2 teaspoons honey and 2 teaspoon lemon juice. Stir until the honey has disappeared into the hot water. Taste, and add 1 teaspoon honey for more sweetness, and/or 1 teaspoon more lemon juice for more zing. Taste again and then add more whiskey. Have one more taste and then a bit more whiskey. Garnish with a lemon round and cinnamon stick (if using).

"Adore You" - Harry Styles



1 box Betty Crocker™ yellow cake mix 3/4 cup apple cider 1/2 cup butter, melted 4 eggs 2 teaspoons ground cinnamon 1 teaspoon ground nutmeg 1 cup coarsely shredded peeled tart apples

Toppings

3 tablespoons butter, melted 1/4 cup sugar 1 teaspoon ground cinnamon

Instructions

Heat oven to 350°F. Generously spray 12-cup fluted tube cake pan with baking spray with flour.

In large bowl, beat cake mix, apple cider, 1/2 cup melted butter, the eggs, 2 teaspoons cinnamon and the nutmea with electric mixer on medium speed 2 minutes, scraping bowl occasionally. Stir in apples. Pour into pan Bake 35 to 40 minutes or until toothpick inserted in center comes out clean. Remove from oven. Let stand 20 minutes; run metal spatula around outer and inside edges of pan to loosen cake. Remove from pan to cooling rack; place cooling rack over waxed paper Brush top and sides of cake with 3 tablespoons melted butter. In small bowl. mix sugar and 1 teaspoon cinnamon until blended. Press 2 tablespoons cinnamon mixture up side and top of cake with hand. Let stand 20 minutes. Repeat with remaining cinnamon mixture. Cool completely, about 1 hour

- 8 oz cream cheese softened

Instructions

Crush the Oreo Cookies in a food processor. Mix the cookie crumbs with the cream cheese until well blended. Scoop about 1.5 TBSP of the cookie mixture and roll each scoop into a ball. Place Oreo balls on a parchment or wax paper lined cookies sheet. Freeze the balls for 20-30 minutes before dipping (very important step. Melt the candy coating or melting chocolate. Dip each ball in the

chocolate and place back on the lined pan. Decorate before the chocolate dries.

Blend to your desired thickness and enjoy!












