

CROSSROADS TIPPED COWHIDE

PRODUCT DESCRIPTION:

Crossroads Tipped Cowhide is an aniline-dyed, Finished cowhide that has been embossed with a small scaled, embossed woven-like texture that has been very popular for upholstery applications for decades.

CHARACTERISTICS:

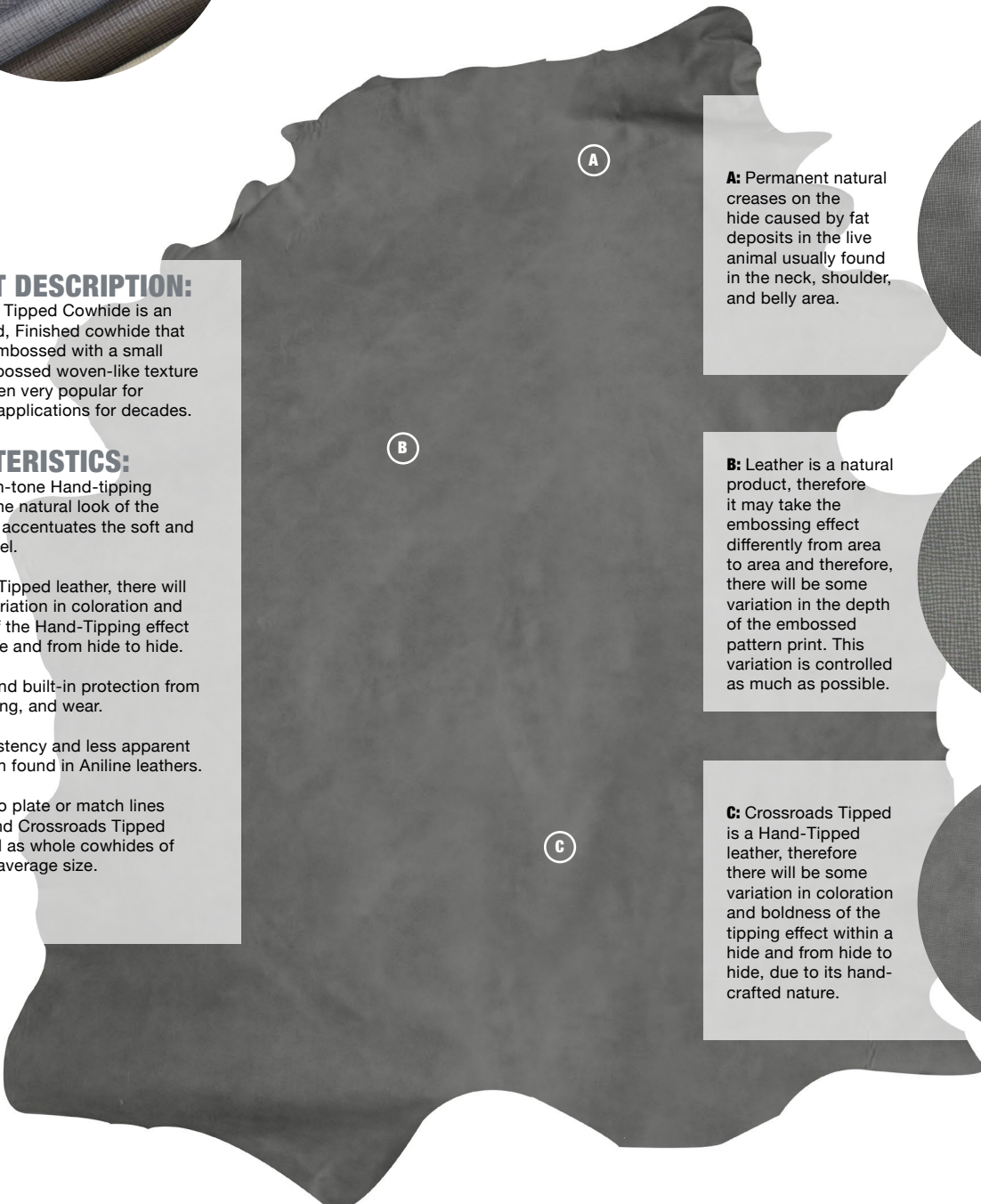
The tone-on-tone Hand-tipping enhances the natural look of the leather and accentuates the soft and luxurious feel.

As a Hand-Tipped leather, there will be some variation in coloration and boldness of the Hand-Tipping effect within a hide and from hide to hide.

Durability and built-in protection from soiling, fading, and wear.

More consistency and less apparent defects than found in Aniline leathers.

There are no plate or match lines apparent and Crossroads Tipped is produced as whole cowhides of 55—60 SF average size.

A: Permanent natural creases on the hide caused by fat deposits in the live animal usually found in the neck, shoulder, and belly area.

B: Leather is a natural product, therefore it may take the embossing effect differently from area to area and therefore, there will be some variation in the depth of the embossed pattern print. This variation is controlled as much as possible.

C: Crossroads Tipped is a Hand-Tipped leather, therefore there will be some variation in coloration and boldness of the tipping effect within a hide and from hide to hide, due to its hand-crafted nature.
