PRODUCT DESCRIPTION:

Fierce Fish Cowhide is Aniline, embossed, and Hand-Tipped leather. Fierce Fish is meant to reinterpret the exotic and weathered look of aquatic life on leather. It is premium nubuck cowhide, embossed in a choice of sealife-inspired embossing patterns and hand-tipped with multiple pigments.

CHARACTERISTICS:

With the hand-crafted nature of this product, variations in color and texture should be expected as part of the natural beauty of this leather.

As an Aniline leather, Fierce Fish Cowhide does not have the full coverage of a pigmented formula as a Finished leather does; there will be natural variations in color, tone, and texture and each hide's unique history and natural markings will be highlighted.

As a Hand-Tipped leather, there will be some variation in coloration and boldness of the tipping effect within a hide and from hide to hide.

A sample is not necessarily representative of the overall effects of this leather.

Due to lack of full finish coverage, this product type is subject to more soiling, fading, and wear.

A: Fierce Fish Cowhide is an Aniline leather, with no consistent surface pigments; there will be natural color shading within a hide and from hide to hide.
