

## GAUCHO SUEDE COWHIDE PRODUCT CHARACTERISTIC SHEET

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**A:** Gaucho Suede is an Aniline leather, with very light surface pigments; there will be natural color shading within a skin and from skin to skin.



## **PRODUCT DESCRIPTION:**

Gaucho Suede is an aniline-dyed, soft cowhide split suede brushed to a luxurious nap and hand-antiqued to produce an aged and distressed look that is at once shiny and matte. A special tanning process imparts limited stain resistance to this natural leather.

Gaucho Suede is available in this handantiqued, weatherworn look without any pattern or in a choice of 2 patterns: Mosaic and Palm Damask.

## **CHARACTERISTICS:**


Natural variations in color, tone and texture are part of the beauty of this leather artwork and highlight each hide's unique history and natural markings.

As an Aniline leather, Gaucho Suede Cowhide does not have the full coverage of a pigmented formula as a Finished leather does; there will be natural variations in color, tone, and texture and each hide's unique history and natural markings will be highlighted.

These are small skins, averaging 18 - 22 SF in size.

leathers are Hand-Tipped leather, therefore there will be some variation in coloration and boldness of the rubbing effect within a skin and from skin to skin, due to its handcrafted nature.

D: Leather is a natural product, therefore it may take the embossing effect differently from area to area and therefore, there will be some variation in the depth of the embossed pattern print. This variation is controlled as much as possible.
