CHARACTERISTICS:

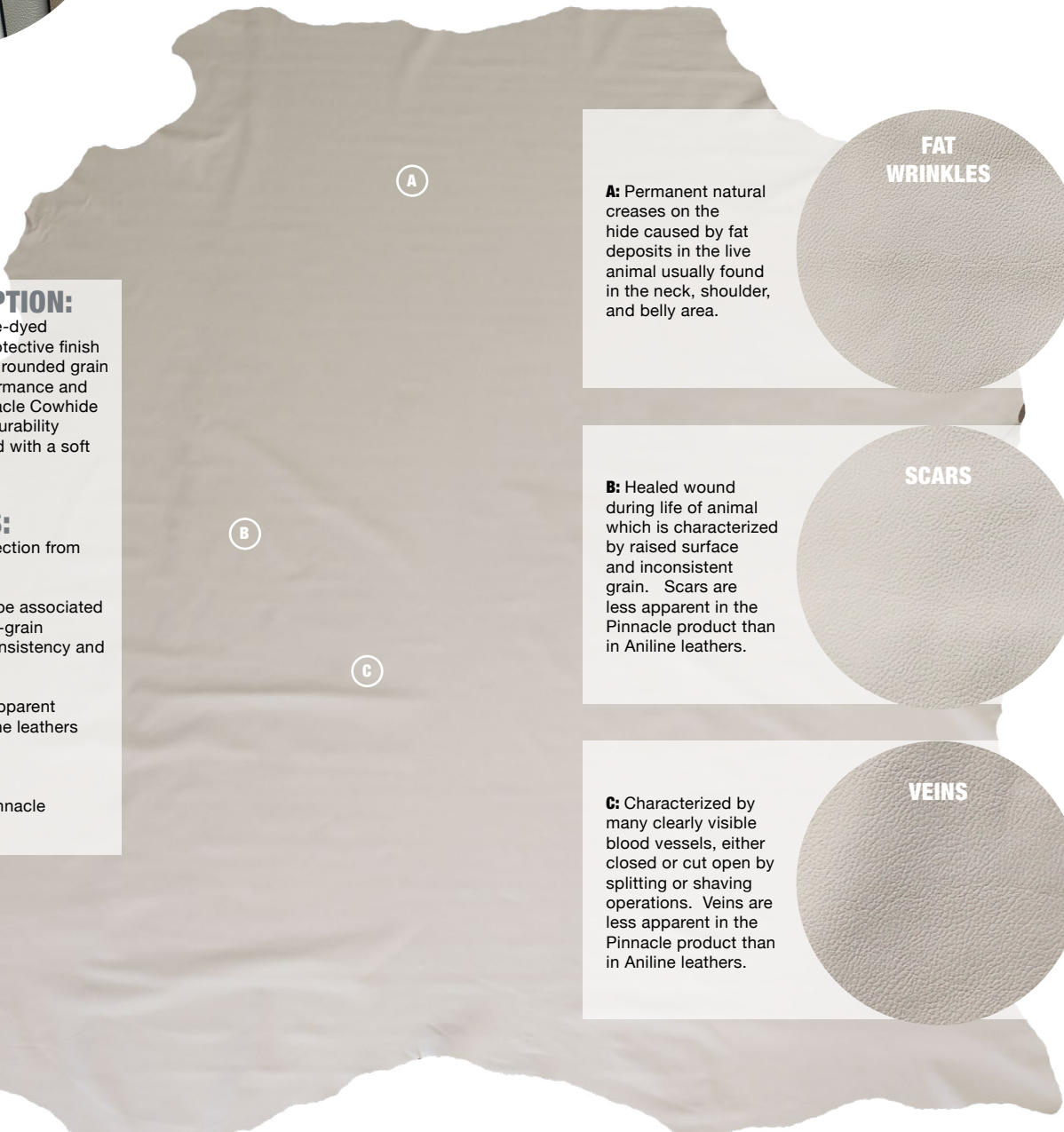
Durability and built-in protection from soiling, fading, and wear.

A: Permanent natural creases on the hide caused by fat deposits in the live animal usually found in the neck, shoulder, and belly area.

B

B: Healed wound during life of animal which is characterized by raised surface and inconsistent grain. Scars are less apparent in the Pinnacle product than in Aniline leathers.

SCARS

C

C: Characterized by many clearly visible blood vessels, either closed or cut open by splitting or shaving operations. Veins are less apparent in the Pinnacle product than in Aniline leathers.
