

# BOMBER SUEDE COWHIDE

## PRODUCT DESCRIPTION:

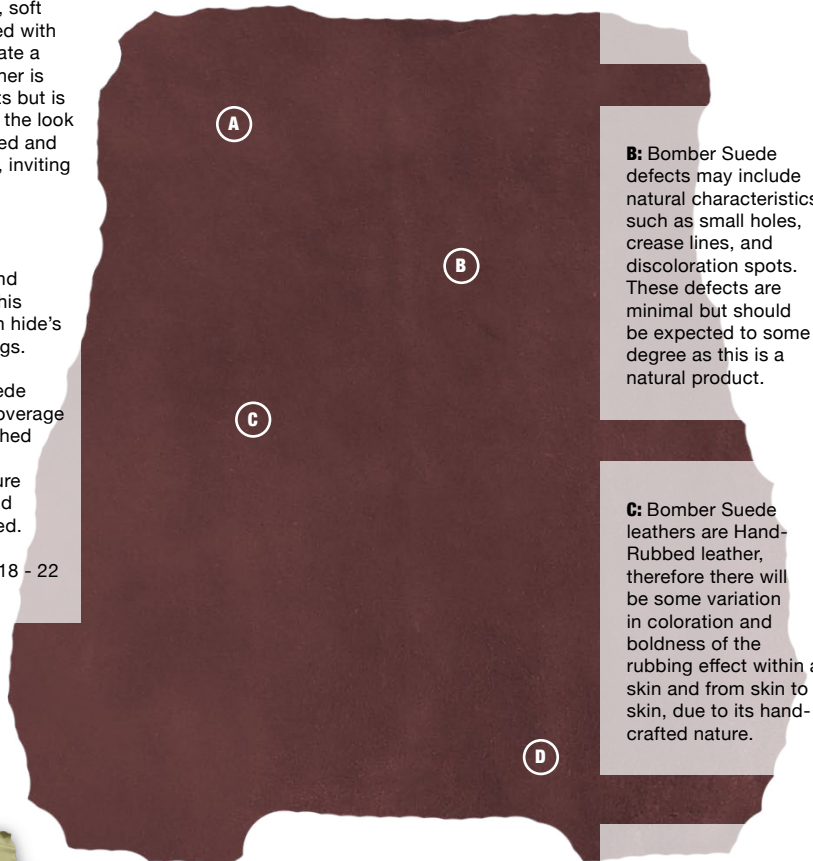
Bomber Suede is an aniline-dyed, soft cowhide split suede that is finished with pigment and a special wax to create a natural distressed look. This leather is inspired by Bomber leather jackets but is made on upholstery hides. It has the look of a suede that has been well-loved and lived in for many years and a soft, inviting feel to the hand.

## CHARACTERISTICS:

Natural variations in color, tone and texture are part of the beauty of this leather artwork and highlight each hide's unique history and natural markings.

As an Aniline leather, Bomber Suede Cowhide does not have the full coverage of a pigmented formula as a Finished leather does; there will be natural variations in color, tone, and texture and each hide's unique history and natural markings will be highlighted.

These are small skins, averaging 18 - 22 SF in size.

**A:** Bomber Suede is an Aniline leather, with very light surface pigments; there will be natural color shading within a skin and from skin to skin.

**B:** Bomber Suede defects may include natural characteristics such as small holes, crease lines, and discoloration spots. These defects are minimal but should be expected to some degree as this is a natural product.

**C:** Bomber Suede leathers are Hand-Rubbed leather, therefore there will be some variation in coloration and boldness of the rubbing effect within a skin and from skin to skin, due to its hand-crafted nature.

**D:** Characterized by many clearly visible blood vessels, either closed or cut open by splitting or shaving operations.
